

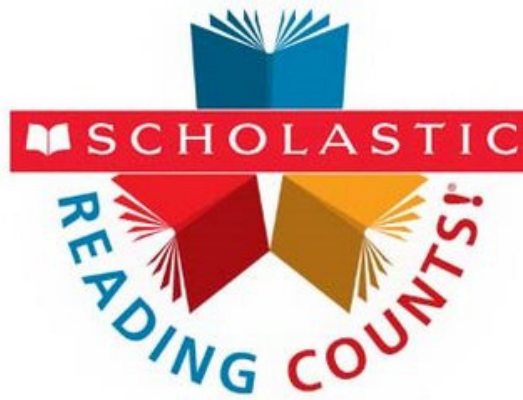

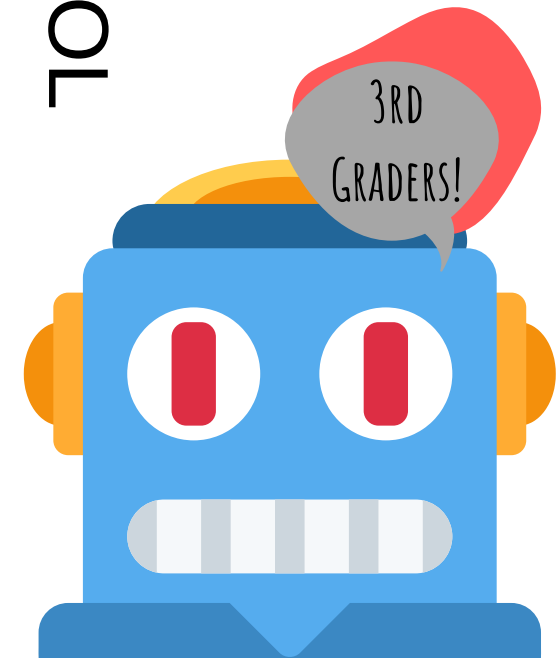
STEAM Night is a great opportunity to experience some of the Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math opportunities offered at Stewart Elementary in 4th grade.
